BSC101 - Biblical Studies Certificate – 2022 Sep to Apr 2023

20 Credit Hours

Prerequisites: Basic school of education, secondary school of education or higher and a must pass in Form 4 or higher, proficiency in English both verbal and written, computer literate, be familiar with Office Word and Internet.

This program provides a bird's eye view of the entire Old Testament, including the pre-Genesis one and the antediluvian period. Emphasis is placed on how the various books of the Bible correlate, thus providing a historical perspective and laying a foundation for interpreting the scriptures. Students will become familiar with the basic theme and general content of Bible Doctrines coupled with Old Testament Themes and New Testament revelation.

BSD301 - Advanced Biblical Studies Diploma – 2022 Sep – Apr 2023

20 Credit Hours

Prerequisites: Biblical Studies certificate (WITS) or a theological certificate or theological diploma from a recognized institution, secondary school of education or higher and a must pass in Form 4 or higher, proficiency in English both verbal and written, computer literate, be familiar with Office Word and Internet.

This program focus on Leadership in Ministry, Theology of Worship, Spiritual Formation, and Theological Divisions. This includes God, His word (Scripture), and that which is associated with faith, Church, and ministry. Apart from God being the central point for theological reflection, one cannot also do theology without the Scripture.

PD320 - Pastors Diploma – 2022 Sep – Apr 2023

20 Credit Hours:

Prerequisite: Church Pastor, Designed exclusively for Pastors. Secondary school of education or higher and a must pass in Form 4 or higher, proficiency in English both verbal and written, computer literate, be familiar with Office Word and internet.

This Program focus on Defense of the Gospel, Bibliology, Ethics, Merging Family & Ministry, Counseling Overview, Conflicts in Ministry, Multiple views of Biblical Interpretation, Summary Homiletics, Hermeneutics



MT401 - Master of Arts Pastoral Theology – 2022 Sep – Apr 2023

30 Credit Hours

Prerequisite: Pastors Diploma (WITS), Designed for Pastors. Secondary school of education or higher and a must pass in Form 4 or higher, proficiency in English both verbal and written, computer literate, be familiar with Office Word and Internet.

This program combines Systematic Theology with a focus on developing pastoral skills. A Practical Theological view of World Religions. Handling disruptions and conflicts within the Body of Christ, Spiritual Formation, Homiletics, Hermeneutics. Thesis.

MS401 - Master of Arts Biblical Studies – 2022 Sep – Apr 2023

30 Credit Hours

Prerequisite: University or College Degree

The program focus on Leadership in Ministry, Theology of Worship, Spiritual Formation, Bible Doctrine, Theological Divisions, and Thesis.

MM101 - Certificate – Ministry & Money Management – Sep to Dec 2022 and Jan to Apr 2023

Prerequisite: Basic school of education, secondary school of education or higher and a must pass in Form 4 or higher, proficiency in English both verbal and written, computer literate, be familiar with Office Word and Internet.

This program focus on Understanding of Finance Management and Financial Reports.

MT101 - Certificate – Ministry & Technology – Sep to Dec 2022 and Jan to Apr 2023
