BSC101 - Biblical Studies Certificate

20 Credit Hours

Program Overview

This program provides a bird's-eye view of the Old Testament, including the pre-Genesis and antediluvian periods. Emphasis is placed on how the various books of the Bible correlate, thus providing a historical perspective and laying a foundation for interpreting the scriptures. Students will become familiar with the basic theme and general content of Bible Doctrines coupled with Old Testament Themes and New Testament revelation.

Prerequisites

Basic school of education, secondary school of education or higher, Proficiency in verbal and written English, computer knowledge, and familiarity with Office Word and the Internet.

BSD301 - Advanced Biblical Studies Diploma

20 Credit Hours

Program Overview

This program focuses on Leadership in Ministry, Theology of Worship, Spiritual Formation, and Theological Divisions. It includes God, His word (Scripture), the association with faith, the Church, and ministry. Attention is given to Christian Conduct (Ethics). Eschatology (study of the end times and the multiple views). Present-Day World Conditions.

Prerequisites

Biblical Studies certificate (WITS) Or one of the following: a theological certificate, a theological diploma from a recognized institution, a secondary school of education or higher. Proficiency in verbal and written English, computer knowledge, and familiarity with Office Word and the Internet.

PD320 - Pastors Diploma

20 Credit Hours

Program Overview

This Program focuses on the Defense of the Gospel (Apologetics), Bibliology, Pastoral Ethics, Merging Family & Ministry, Counseling Overview, Conflicts in Ministry, Multiple views of Biblical Interpretation, Thinking Theologically, and Introduction to Greek & Hebrew. Homiletics and Hermeneutics Overview. Sermon Preparation, Sermon

Dismantling disruptions and conflicts within the Body of Christ, Spiritual Formation, Characteristics of The Word, Practical Theology, Introduction to Greek & Hebrew, Homiletics, and Hermeneutics. Thesis.

MS401 - Master of Arts Biblical Studies

30 Credit Hours

Program Overview

The program focuses on Leadership in Ministry (Laws of Leadership), Systematic Theology (Divisions and Doctrine), Theology of Worship, A Glance at Greek and Hebrew, Characteristics of the Word, Spiritual Formation, and Bible Doctrine. Thesis.

Prerequisites

WITS Advanced Diploma and WITS Bridge Paper, or University / College Certificate or Degree, or a Biblical Studies Diploma, or Pastoral Studies Diploma from a recognized Institution.
